

## MINUTES OF THE DDC MEETING HELD ON 05.12.2022 AT 11.00 AM IN THE CONFERENCE HALL, DEPUTY COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE, DHUBRI

Member present: As per Annexure:- 'A'

The meeting was presided by Smti Kanta Das, ACS, District Development Commissioner, Dhubri. At the outset, she welcomed all the members present in the meeting.

Thereafter, the District Development Commissioner reviewed the departments as follows:

### 1. AH & VETERINARY:

In a query from the Chair, DVO stated that under the Foot & Mouth Disease (FMD) control programme 38,285 no.s of animals have been covered out of 74,000 target in this month. Regarding fodder cultivation scheme, DVO informed that the department has received 72 nos. applications against target of 200 nos. of farmers. DVO also highligted a issue regarding animal tagging that the ear tags have been removed by public in some areas. The chairperson directed DVO to intimate the same to the Deputy Commissioner, Dhubri in black & white for initiating necessary action.

#### 2. FISHERY:

DFDO informed the house that RIDF-XXIII (Ghare Ghare Pukhuri Ghare Ghare Maach) scheme will be completed by Dec. 2022.

### 3. SOCIAL WELFARE:

DSWO informed the house that the Hon'ble CM has asked the contractors to start immediate repair of the Anganwadi centres in district which require minor repairing. DSWO also stated that the department has already prepared a list of 100 nos. of Anganwadi centre for that purpose.

Further, DSWO stated that wiring of electricity in some of the Anganwadi centres have not been safely completed inviting a risk of life to the children. In reply AGM, APDCL, Dhubri informed that he has already directed the contractors to resolve these issues and requested DSWO to submit a complete list of such Anganwadi centres wherein electricity connection has been taken up. The Chairperson directed DSWO to liaise with APDCL in this regard.

DSWO also stated that the department has faced problem to arrange a disability camp due to non-availability of sufficient specialized Doctor. The Chairperson instructed DSWO to write a letter to the Govt. through D.C, Dhubri in this regard.

### 4. EDUCATION:

Regarding Electrification of School, I.S., Dhubri informed the house that they have already submitted a list of 38 nos. of school that has not been electrified. In reply AGM, APDCL assured the house that electrification of those left out schools will be completed by 31st Dec. 2022.

### 5. <u>WATER RESOURCES</u>:

While reviewed the schemes under W.R. Department, the E.E., Water Resources, Dhubri stated that acquisition of land for a project at Fakirganj area funded by Asian Development Bank is required. The Chairperson directed E.E., W.R. Dhubri to communicate with the concerned C.O. in this regard.

#### 6. P.W.D. (BUILDING):

The matter of delayed completion of different infrastructure works taken up at Madhupur Sattra was strongly reviewed. The E.E. PWD (B) stated that he has been pressing hard the contractor to complete the work within stipulated time.

In a query from the chair regarding construction of a new Polytechnic at Agomani, E.E. PWD (B) requested the Chairman to resolve the land dispute created by a lady for which the department has a possession over only a small part of the land so that the work could be started after resolving the issues with proper demarcation of the land.

Referring to a discussion of the last DDC meeting, the E.E. PWD (R) informed that the construction of Indo-Bangladesh Border Gate at Bishkhowa will be resumed and the same could be completed within one week subject to renovation of the road leading to construction site as taken up out of MGNREGA fund. The PD, DRDA informed that the proposal of renovation of the road has been placed before DC awaiting approval.

### 7. **DI&CC**:

While reviewed the status of PMEGP, the chair expressed concern over poor performance. The GM stated that a number of loan applications are not sanctioned from the different banks leading to poor performance on progress of PMEGP. The Chairperson asked GM to convene DLMC meeting to discuss various issues immediately

On a matter of renewal of the training centre under PMKVY and as requested by the KGM Immigration and Educational Consultants Pvt. Ltd., the General Manager, DI&CC, Dhubri replied that the agreement with the NGO has already been expired after the training programme is over and the NGO has agreed to vacate the campus shortly. Further, he added that the department will require the campus for its own training purposes for which it will be difficult to renew the agreement.

### 8. APDCL:

AGM, APDCL highlighted the land issue of ongoing construction of a control room of APDCL at the premises of BDO Office, Dharmasala. The Chairperson directed CEO, Zila Parishad to look into the matter.

### 9. <u>MISCELLANEOUS</u>:-

The meeting reviewed the progress and status report with regard to opening of children's Bank Account. LDM, Dhubri stated that as per Guideline of RBI Pan Card is not mandatory to open Bank Account for children and alternatively the Bank may take AAdhar to open the children's Bank Account. The Chairperson instructed LDM to ensure attendance of the Bank Managers in the meeting during holding of the camps at School to expedite the process and to complete the task by 31st Dec. 2022.

The Chair instructed all the HODs to ensure submission of their DDC meeting report on or before last day of every month and NITI AAyog report on or before 2<sup>nd</sup> of every month to enable its review and placement before the next DDC meeting regularly.

The meeting then ended with vote of thanks from the Chair.
