MINUTES OF DDC MEETING HELD ON 26.04.2023 AT 11.00 AM IN THE CONFERENCE HALL,
DEPUTY COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE, DHUBRI

Member present: As per Annexure: - 'A'

The meeting was presided over by Sri Dibakar Nath, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Dhubri. After the welcome address, he introduced Sri Pallab Mazumdar, ACS who joined as the District Development Commissioner, Dhubri recently.

Thereafter, The Chair discussed and reviewed progress made under major and important schemes of different departments as follows:

1. FISHERY :

The meeting reviewed progress of different schemes under Fishery Department. The Deputy Commissioner, Dhubri asked the officer about availability of community fishery tank in the district which need further excavation. DFDO, Dhubri informed that there are more than 97 nos. of small fishery tanks run by the SHG which need no excavation for siltation. The Chair asked the officer to submit a list of small beel in Govt. khas land. DFDO, Dhubri stated that some of the community fisheries have already been taken up under Amrit Saravaor Mission.

Referring to the discussion held in the last DDC meeting, District Development Commissioner, Dhubri asked DFDO about the practicability of Biofloc as income source to the farmers. DFDO stated that two nos. of Biofloc at Chapar and one at Agomani have been taken under PMMSY which are running as a profitable business. DDC, Dhubri asked the officer to increase nos. of Biofloc considering high demand of fish market with generation of income to the farmers.

The Chair asked the officer to complete atleast 10 nos. of FIG for doubling farmers' income with submission of details along with demand for new fisheries. Participating in the discussion, DAO, Dhubri informed that there is a demand for new fisheries in Golakganj area. The Chair asked both the officers to take further steps to construct community fishery tank with collaborative effort.

2. SOCIAL WELFARE :

The meeting reviewed progress of the different schemes under Social Welfare department. In a reply from the chair, DSWO informed that construction of three nos. of AWC taken up out of the sanctioned amount from NITI Aayog have been found still incomplete. The name of the AWC are as follows:

1. 150 No Alomganj pt-VII under Debitola ICDS Project
2. 48 No Alomganj pt-IX under Debitola ICDS Project
3. 70 No Koimarir under Agomoni ICDS Project

The chair asked DDC, Dhubri to look into the matter and ensure completion at an early date.

The DSWO was also asked to visit following four nos. of AWCs to ensure its proper functioning and attendance of student with a direction to submit a report immediately.

- i. 50 No Sonamukhi
- ii. 152 No Santoshpur-Namapara
- iii. 158 No Nayeralga
- iv. 16 No Dheer Beel

3. P.W.D. (R) :

The Chairperson expressed dissatisfaction over the performance of PWD (R) Bilasipara Divn. The Chair asked EE, PWD (R), Bilasipara Divn. to explain the reasons for non-completion of some of the works in spite of lapse of more than 2 -3 years and submit a report within 7 days.

Due to absence of EE, PWD (R), Dhubri Division., the meeting could not review the progress of the works under Dhubri Divn.

4. DI&CC :

requested the Chair to allot a different location for CRPF for smooth functioning of the works of DICC Office, Gauripur.

The Chair asked the officer about unutilized existing buildings of DICC at different locations of the district. The GM, DICC informed that there are 2 nos. of building in dilapidated condition located at Halakura and Lakhiganj. The DC asked the officer to share photographs of those building to him.

The meeting could not review the progress under Mukhya Mantri Thaluwa Udyog Bikash Achoni due to dissimilarity of figures submitted in his report.

Further, in respect of PMEGP, the officer was asked to submit a detailed report incorporating with financial achievement.

5. Agriculture :-

The meeting reviewed the progress of different schemes under Agriculture Department. In a reply from the chair, DAO, Dhubri informed that a total of 19,000 nos of beneficiaries have received the last installment of grants under PMKISAN.

The Chair instructed the officer to conduct enquiry to ascertain whether the tractors received under CMSGUY are utilized in agriculture purpose or not as reportedly some of beneficiary farmers are using the Govt subsidized tractor in other than agriculture purpose.

The Chair expressed concern over the poor performance of the target of STW under Rural Infrastructure Development Fund (RIDF). DAO, Dhubri informed that though the department has a target of 200 nos of beneficiaries under this scheme but due to non-receipt of beneficiaries share, the department is unable to pay the rest of the government subsidizes @ 85% against the beneficiaries.

The Chair stated that poor performance of the schemes has a direct affect on the ranking of the district under Aspirational District Programme. The Chair instructed DAO to take collaborative efforts with DPM, ASRLM with a view to set up Farmer Interest Group for different schemes which fall under the pattern of community level participation.

6. PWD(B):-

The EE, PWD(B) highlighted some issues about handing and taking over of some schemes after its completion. The chair directed EE, PWD to submit a list of such projects mentioning the name of proposed authority for future maintenance of the projects.

Referring to the discussion held in earlier DDC meeting, EE, PWD(B) raised the land acquisition issue of Agomoni Polytechnic and requested the Chair to provide 10 bighas of land for playground of Bilasipara Women College.

The Chair sought information in regard to Chilarai Kalakhetra Project at Golakganj. EE, PWD(B) replied that the boundary wall of the project has already been constructed by the department. The Chair instructed EE, PWD(B) to submit a detailed report on Chilarai Kalakhetra Project at Golakganj.

7. Veterinary :-

The DVO, Dhubri raised the issue of a number of half-done works of Dhubri Veterinary Hospital, Binnachara State Veterinary, Gauripur Veterinary Officers' Quarter, Sapatgram State Veterinary. The DVO also informed that the department has facing a lot of problem to carry out day to day activities as more than 50 percent of the existing building was dismantled in order to carry out new construction. The Chair asked E.E, PWD to explain the reasons for the non-completion of works. In this regard, the E.E. PWD (Bldg.) replied that the scheme has been closed by the concerned department under which the projects were running. He also mentioned that the estimate for balance work has been submitted to the Veterinary department awaiting sanction of fund.

The Chair directed DVO to ensure involvement of Self-help group in different training programmes of the department for fruitful implementation of the schemes.

8. APDCL :-

The meeting reviewed the progress of different works under APDCL. AGM, APDCL informed that issues related to Anganwadi Centres will be sorted out within 15 days. In respect of revenue collection, the AGM, APDCL informed that the collection of revenue is not satisfactory.

disconnection of power supply with prior intimation to police and make a speaking order mentioning the law under which electricity will be cut off.

9. **Soil Conservation :-**

The Chair expressed concerned over the poor performance of different schemes of the department in the district. He stated that performance of the department is very poor as compared to other districts. The Chair enquired Ranger, Soil Conservation whether any monitoring was done on the projects of the department at Champawati & Gaurang river prior to release of fund.

The Chair expressed dissatisfaction on submission of action plan without involving SHG. The Ranger replied that they have faced problem of inadequate nos. of SHG at some locations. The Chair asked Ranger to make liaison with DPM, ASRLM for involvement of SHG.

The Chair directed the Officer to submit a report mentioning the details of Water Shed area and committees in the district.

10. **Irrigation:**

Referring to the discussion incorporated in the last DDC minutes, EE (IR) informed that the nos. of solar operated STW should be read as 48 nos. instead of 52 and all the STWs are working well. The EE, Irrigation also mentioned that out of 12 units of newly sanctioned solar operated STW, installation of 6 nos of STW have already been completed and installation of the remaining six nos. will take some time due to standing crops at the farmers' field. However more than 35% of works have been completed against 6 nos. of STW and the contractor was asked to complete the task immediately. He informed about storm damaged of 3 units of STW at Gauripur area for which a proposal was sent to Disaster Management for approval awaiting release of fund. The Chair asked the officer to inform coverage of command areas through irrigation during last five years.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks from the Chair.
