Foreword

In Pursuance to the Gazette Notification, published by the Ministry of Environment, Forest, and Climate Change (MoEF&CC), the Government of India, Notification No. S. O. 141(E) Appendix-X, Dated 15.01.2016 and S.O. 3611 (E) New Delhi 25th July 2018 laid procedure for preparation of District Survey Report of Sand mining or river bed mining and minor minerals other than Sand mining or river bed mining.

The notification and guidelines suggest the preparation of the District Survey Report for the better management of the Sand and Silt extraction. The main purpose of the District Survey Report (DSR) is identification of areas of aggregations or deposition where mining can be allowed; and identification of areas of erosion and proximity to infrastructural structures and installations where mining should be prohibited". This District survey report of Dhubri District, Assam State has been prepared as per the guidelines and notification, for the better management of Sand, Sill, stone and other minor mineral Earth Mining.

Enforcement and Monitoring Guidelines for Sand Mining (EMGSM) January 2020, issued by the Ministry of Environment. Forest and Climate Change is prepared in consideration of various orders/directions issued by Hon'ble NGT in matters pertaining to illegal sand mining and also based on the reports submitted by expert committees and investigation teams. This DSR-Part-II has been prepared in conformity with the S O 141 (E), S O 3611 (E), and other sand mining guidelines published by MOEF&CC from time to time as well as the requirement specified in AMMCR, 2013.

The main objective of the preparation of District Survey Report (as per the Sustainable Sand Mining Guideline) is to ensure the following:

- (i) Identification of areas of aggradations or deposition where mining can be allowed;
- (ii) Identification of areas of erosion and proximity to infrastructural structures and installations where mining should be prohibited and calculation of annual rate of replenishment and allowing time for replenishment after mining in that area;
- (iii) Identification of mineral wealth in the district;
- (iv) Identification of areas where there is no mining zone.

CHAPTER – I INTRODUCTION

District Survey Report (DSR) Part-II for Ordinary Earth (Minor Mineral) Dhubri District, Assam

1.1 Statutory Framework

Preparation of the District Survey Report (DSR) is mandated under the Sustainable Sand Mining Management Guidelines, 2016 and the Enforcement & Monitoring Guidelines for Sand Mining, 2020 issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (MOEF&CC), Government of India. The DSR is a prerequisite document for identification, regulation, and environmental appraisal of minor mineral mining activities within a district, including ordinary earth.

In compliance with the above guidelines, the District Survey Report for Minor Minerals of Dhubri District was prepared and placed before the State Expert Appraisal Committee (SEAC) on 21.07.2025 and subsequently approved by the State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Assam on 01.09.2025. The approved DSR has been uploaded on the official district portal and is currently operational.

However, the approved DSR did not envisage certain additional ordinary earth mining requirements that emerged subsequently due to large-scale infrastructure and linear development projects. Therefore, preparation of District Survey Report Part-II has become necessary as a supplementary document to the earlier approved DSR.

1.2 Rationale for Preparation of DSR Part-II

Ordinary earth is categorized as a minor mineral under the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 and is primarily utilized for development-oriented activities such as:

- Construction and widening of National Highways and State Highways
- Railway formation works
- Embankments and flood protection works
- Industrial and commercial platform leveling

- Linear infrastructure projects and public utility works

Unlike other minor minerals such as riverbed sand or stone aggregates, ordinary earth mining is project-specific, necessity-based, and seasonal. The identification of ordinary earth mining sites cannot be undertaken comprehensively at the district level in advance, as such sites are determined based on the alignment, design, and execution requirements of individual projects.

National Highways & Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (NHIDCL) are under execution. These projects require substantial quantities of ordinary earth within a defined construction period, necessitating identification of additional extraction sites beyond those included in the original DSR.

Accordingly, DSR Part-II has been prepared to document and regulate these additional ordinary earth mining areas in a structured and environmentally compliant manner.

1.3 Characteristics of Ordinary Earth Mining in Dhubri District

Ordinary earth mining activities proposed under DSR Part-II exhibit the following technical and operational characteristics:

The mining operations are not intended for continuous commercial exploitation but are restricted to the execution period of the approved developmental project.

1.4 Land Status and Ownership

The additional ordinary earth mining sites proposed under DSR Part-II are primarily located on Govt. Land & private patta lands, with ownership details verified through revenue records. No forest land is involved in the proposed sites. Site-specific land status verification has been carried out and documented.

1.5 Identification and Verification of Additional Mining Sites

The additional ordinary earth mining sites included in DSR Part-II have been identified based on proposals submitted by user agencies and private applicants. These sites were subjected to joint field verification by the District Level Committee comprising representatives of the following departments:

- Forest Department
- Water Resources Department
- Geology & Mining
- Revenue (Circle Office)

The field verification assessed parameters such as land use, drainage pattern, proximity to habitations, environmental sensitivity, and compliance with MoEF&CC guidelines.

1.6 Environmental Safeguards and Compliance

The proposed ordinary earth mining activities under DSR Part-II are to be regulated strictly in accordance with:

- Sustainable Sand Mining Management Guidelines, 2016
- Enforcement & Monitoring Guidelines for Sand Mining, 2020
- Conditions imposed by SEIAA while granting Environmental Clearance

Key environmental safeguards include controlled depth of excavation, prevention of waterlogging, proper slope stabilization, and restoration of mined areas post-extraction. A standard set of environmental safeguards applicable to all sites is provided in Chapter-6, while site-specific mitigation measures are detailed in Annexure-III.

1.7 Scope and Applicability of DSR Part-II

The District Survey Report Part-II shall function as a supplementary and addendum document to the previously approved DSR of Dhubri District. Its applicability shall be limited to the additional ordinary earth mining sites identified herein and shall not supersede or modify the provisions of the original DSR.

This document has been prepared to ensure that ordinary earth mining activities required for developmental projects are undertaken in a regulated, transparent, and environmentally sustainable manner.

1.8 Approval and Recommendation

The District Survey Report Part-II was placed before the District Level Committee for Preparation of DSR and approved in its meeting held on 05.01.2026. The Committee recommended submission of the approved DSR Part-II to the State Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), Assam for appraisal and final approval.

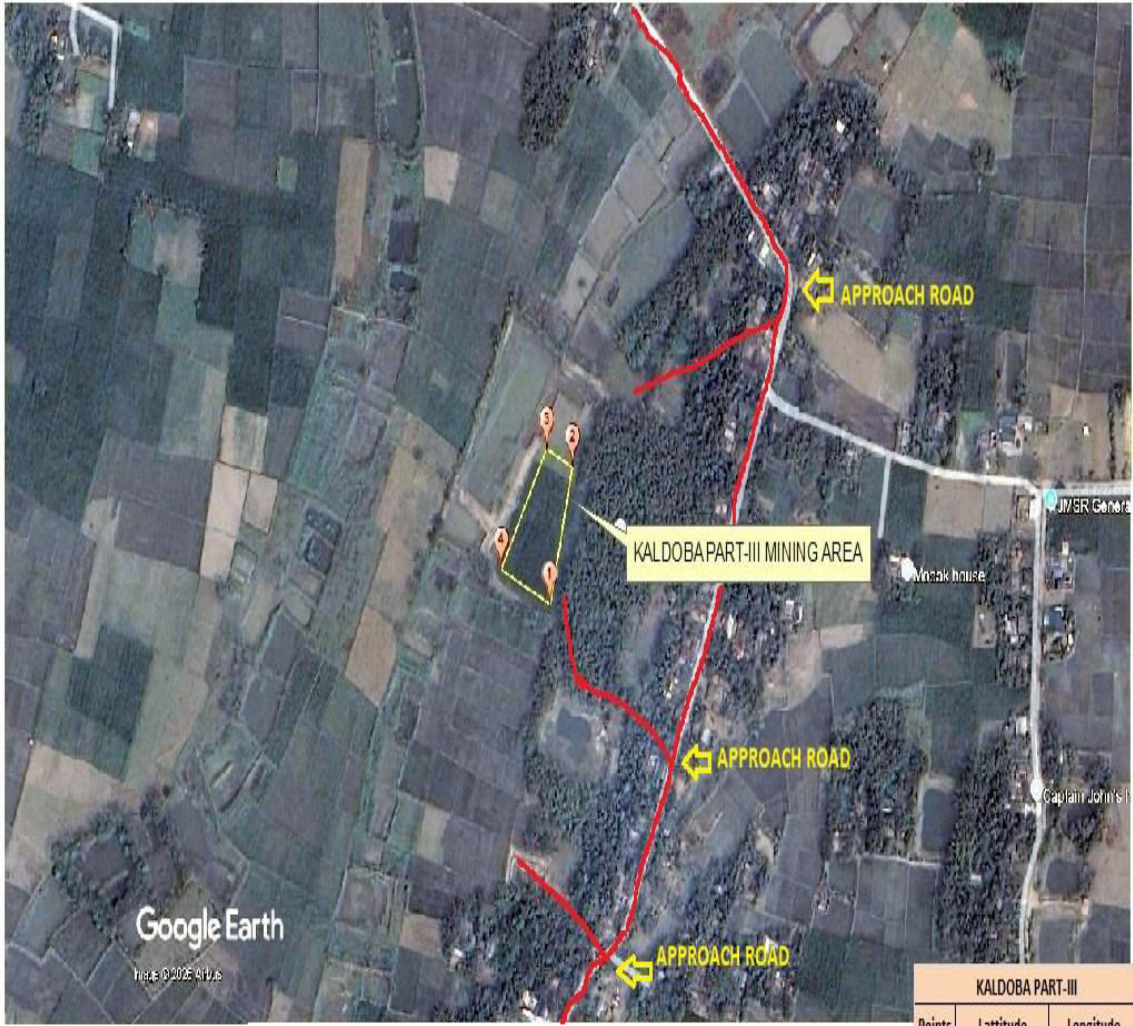




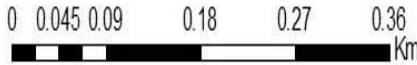




**MAP OF PROPOSED KALDOBA PART-III, KALDOBA PART-II & SHERNAGAR O. EARTH MINING PERMIT AREA

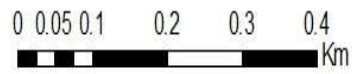


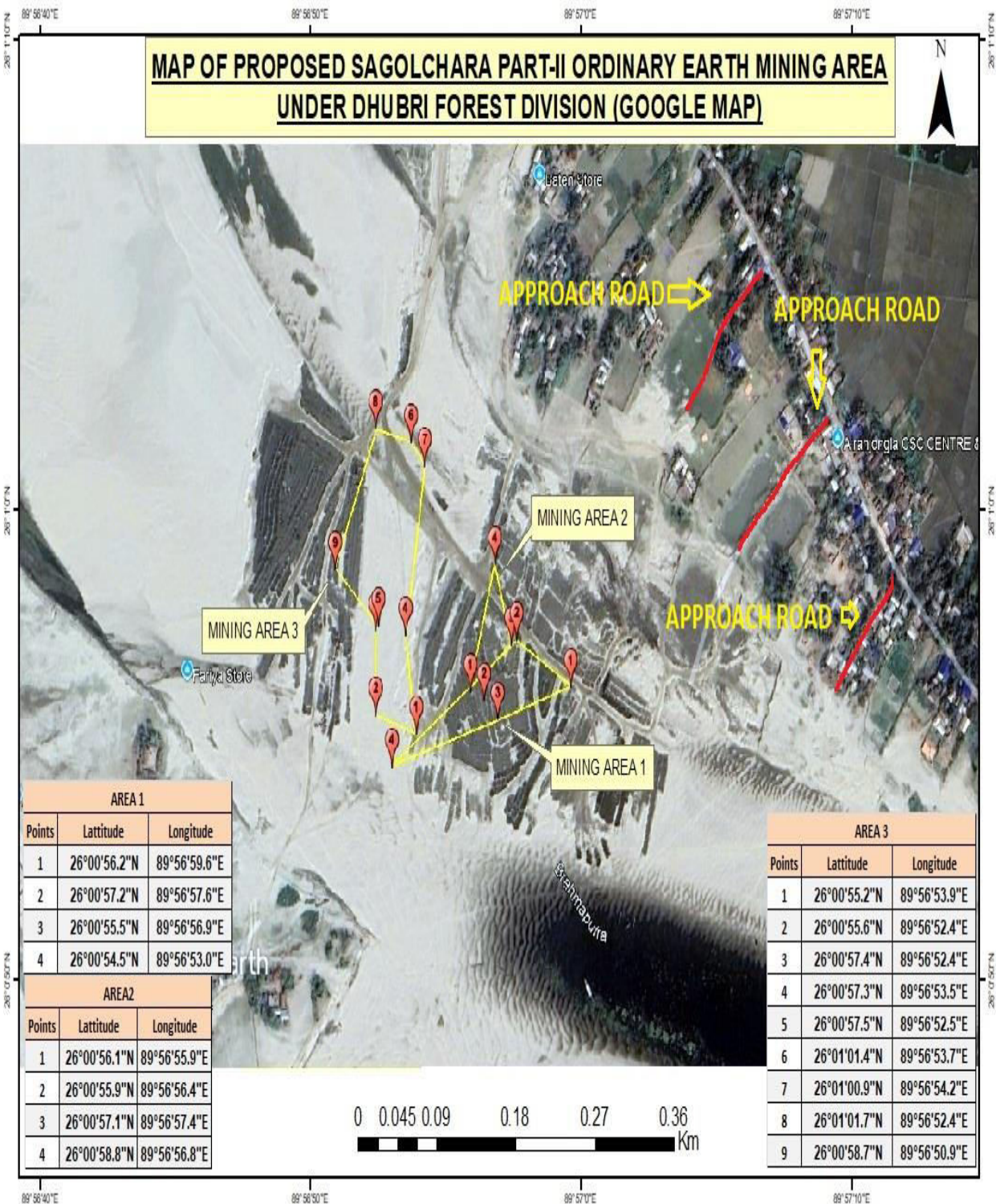
**MAP OF PROPOSED JONGBANDHA PP LAND SAND & GRAVEL MINING PERMIT AREA

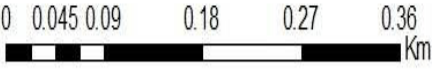

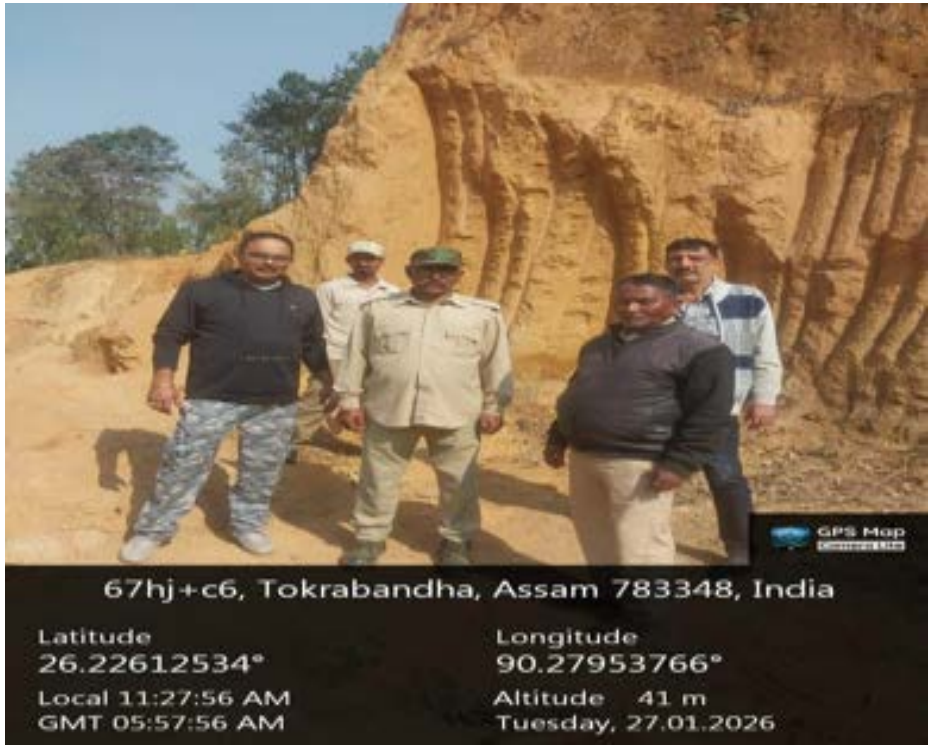


