

Nutrition Rehabilitation Centre (NRC)

Severely malnourished children are often dying because of lack of specialized treatment practices that are not similar for most children, but suitable for severely malnourished (SAM) children. Nutrition Rehabilitation Centres (NRC) are established in Health Facilities to provide appropriate and facility based case management to children with SAM for all under 5 children.

Goal:

The lives of many children with SAM can be saved and cases of fatality rates can be reduced.

Objective:

To provide facility based management to children with SAM

To reduce under 5 mortalities due to Severe Acute Malnutrition.
