

MINUTES OF THE DDC MEETING HELD ON 05.07.2022 AT 11.00AM IN THE CONFERENCE HALL, DEPUTY COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE, DHUBRI

Member present: As per Annexure:- 'A'

The meeting was presided over by Smt.Kanta Das, ACS, District Development Commissioner, Dhubri. She welcomed all the Officials present in the meeting.

The chair reviewed the following departments:

Social Welfare Department:

On query from the Chair, the District Social Welfare Officer informed that he organized meeting with the CDPOs to review present conditions of Anganwadi Centres (AWC) and progress of power connection in AWC.

The Chair asked DSWO to submit a proposal for amalgamation of AWCs wherein numbers of students is less with the nearest AWCs with more numbers of students.

The Chair asked AGM, APDCL, Dhubri to liaise with DSWO to ensure completion of electrification in AWCs.

DSWO was asked to submit a list of all dilapidated AWCs in the district.

Education Department:

While reviewed the progress of the project Arohan, the Inspector of School informed that list of students for the project will be submitted within next 10 days.

The Inspector of School informed that rationalization of schools will initiated following the Zonal Conference scheduled on 15th July/2022 at Bongaigaon.

The Chair requested to prepare a list of teacher to be notified as Nodal Teacher for issuance of Caste Certificate as directed in the DC's conference.

The Inspector of School informed that 29 nos of school in Char areas are still to be electrified.

The Chair requested the AGM, APDCL, Dhubri to take immediate steps for Solarisation of the left out schools.

Health & Family Welfare:

The Chair directed the Joint Director of Health, Dhubri to convene Block Level meetings at villages and public places with gatherings to create awareness against child marriage.

In response to the request made by the Addl. Chief Medical Officer, the Chair requested all the HODs to ensure 100% saturation of Booster dose for COVID to their employees.

The Joint Director of Health requested the Chair to communicate with NHM regarding establishment of a separate Health block for the Health institutions falling under South Salmara Dhubri (part).

PWD (Building):

EE PWD (B), Dhubri Division has raised the following issues and requested the Chair to take necessary action in this regard

- 1. The issue of allotment of land for proposed new Circuit House at Dhubri town as the model plan does not fit in the already allotted land.
- 2. The land dispute of allotted land for the Polytechnic College in Agomoni is still not settled because of which the construction work could not be started.
- 3. The possession of 50 Bighas land for the Medical College is still not received by the Authority of Dhubri Medical College and Hospital.

PWD (Road):

The EE PWD (R), Dhubri Division informed the House that the unmanned Railway crossing at Jhagrarpar which is the main entry point to the DMC&H is posing a threat to Road Safety. PWD (RR) informed the House that necessary communication has been made to the Railway and District Authority for development and setting up of a Railway Gate. He requested the Chair to pursue the matter with the concerned Railway Authority.

Misc:



Mr. Rishikesh Mishra, Senior Program Associate, WRI India submitted response on the queries raised during the previous DDC meeting -

1. PHED: WRI India worked on the data received from PHED department after the previous DDC meeting (June DDC meeting) and shared an estimate report for the Solar based drinking water system for Schools/AWC's located in the Char areas.

He also shared a WRI published report - "Powering Development in Climate Vulnerable Areas: The Role of Decentralized Solar Solutions in India" which have few case studies on DRE from Assam and other parts of the country.

2. Education department- WRI India has developed few documents relating to guidelines and training modules for all those Schools where solarisation is going to take place.

The training modules may be modified as per the local requirements of the Region / Schools.

(Action: WRI & IS)

3. Health - WRI India is still waiting for facility level data from the health department. Once they get these facility level data they will integrate on the EAE platform.

They shall follow up with the concerned department.

(Action: WRI & Joint Director of Health Services)

The Chair instructed all the HODs to ensure submission of their Monthly Reports on or before 25th of every month to enable its review and its placement before DDC Meeting regularly.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks from the Chair.
