MINUTES OF THE DDC MEETING HELD ON 05.11.2019 AT 11.00 AM IN THE CONFERENCE HALL, DEPUTY COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE, DHUBRI



Member present: As per Annexure:- 'A'

The meeting was presided over by Smti. Banashree Nath, ACS, District Development Commissioner, Dhubri. She welcomed all the Officials present in the meeting and initiated discussion on the progress of schemes implemented by the different departments.

1. TOWN & COUNTRY PLANNING:

The Deputy Director, T& CP, Dhubri briefed the house on the implementation of different schemes under his department in the district. The Deputy Director informed that under PMAY-HFU, out of total targeted beneficiaries of 9486, a total of 1328 nos. of houses have reached the completed state. Another 728 nos. of houses are at roof level and 4257 nos. of houses are at lintel level. It was further reported that Geo-tagging of houses has been geared up with the improved app launched by the Central Government.

On query from the Chair, the Deputy. Director, T& CP, Dhubri informed that the fund received under Urban Infrastructure Development Scheme and Integrated Housing & Slum Development Program (IHSDP) has been fully utilised for construction of Drainage, Roads and Dwelling Units and Utilisation Certificate submitted to the Govt.

Further, in case of construction of Sapatgram Town Committee Building under 10% Pool Fund, it has been informed that the Civil Works of the Building has been completed. However, the Electrical works are remained to be done.

The Chairperson requested the Deputy Director, T&CP, Dhubri to delete the names of all such beneficiaries who don't possess land of their own or who are unwilling to take up the scheme. Also, he was directed to gear up the Geo-Tagging process as the same is very slow.

2. FOREST :-

The DFO, Dhubri reported that the Task Force has seized Timber =0.100 cum, Earth=3.778cum, Vehicle=6 nos, Sand = 2.112cum, Stone = 13.678 cum, River Silt collection machine = 1No, Boat = 1 No. in the month of October 2019.

The Chairperson requested the representative of the DFO, Dhubri to submit clarify regarding the content of the letter wherein it has been directed to deduct and deposit 10% of the scheme for DMF in addition to 10% as Forest Royalty.

3. AH & VETERINARY:

The Dist. A.H &Veterinary Officer, Dhubri informed that the target for artificial insemination for the district has been fixed at 20,000 nos. and cumulative achievement of Calf Born till Octber'2019 is 3627nos. Under Prevention of Livestock Diseases, the target is 3,00,000 doses and they have provided 59,568 doses till last month. In case of Deworming of new born Calf, it was reported that so far 7709 nos. of Calf were taken care under the scheme.

On query from the Chair, the Dist. A.H &Veterinary Officer, Dhubri informed that the Census work in the district which was closed on 20.09.2019 will restart to cover up the left out area as informed.

It was also reported that as informed by the Higher Authority, the training to 10 nos. of Gopal Mitra will start from 15th of this month.

The Dist. A.H & Veterinary Officer, Dhubri informed that under the scheme 'National Animal Disease Control', cattle will be treated for Foot & Mouse diseases and for this extra vaccinator will be needed. He informed that necessary Action Plan has been under preparation to implement the scheme.

The Chairperson suggested to take the help of DPM, NRLM for providing persons to be trained as vaccinator. It was also decided that the DVO, Dhubri will place the matter in the GPDPs for appraisal of the public and for this he will contact CEO, ZP, Dhubri for necessary guidance.

4. APDCL:

It was informed by the AGM, Dhubri Electrical Division that they have received 196461 nos. of LED bulbs under MMADY scheme and has so far distributed 85851 (in packet of 4 nos.). Beside they have Electrified a total of 517661 nos. of Households including additional 2711 HH.

The E.E, PHE, Dhubri informed that the electricity connection to Moynabandha PWSS is still pending though they have made payment to AGM, APDCL, Goalpara. The DDC requested AGM, APDCL, Gauripurto take up the matter with his counterpart and solve the problem.

It was also resolved that the APDCL, Gauripur will take measures for providing a separate Electric Meter in favour of DSWO, Dhubri Office which is functioning from a rented House. The expenditure for the cost of Meter will be borne by the DSWO, Dhubri.

The Inspector of Schools, Dhubri requested for providing electricity connection to Chirakuti High School. The DDC, Dhubri being an Aspirational District, all the Educational Institutions of the District are to be covered by the Electricity as directed by the Govt. recently.

The representative of N.H.Way, Abhayapuri Division requested for shifting of Transformer installed near Beparipatty Masjid for installation of Signage in connection to Rupshi Airport. The Chairperson, Dhubri suggested for on the spot visit by the AGM, APDCL, Gauripur and N.H.Way Officials by today itself and sort out the problem.

The AGM, APDCL, Gauripur informed that an Outstanding Bill of Rs. 1.60 lakhs is pending against the F.T Court Building and Inspector of Schools together. It was resolved that a joint team of APDCL, Inspector of Schools and F.T Court will cause an enquiry on the load of energy being used by Inspector of Schools and F.T. Court and accordingly solution may be taken.

It was further informed by the AGM, APDCL, Gauripur that 8 nos. Of Control Units have sanctioned for Dhubri District including two for Bilasipara Sub-Division. He requested SDO (Civil), Bilasipara to allot land near Bilasipara College and at Raniganj.

5. PWD (NH):-

The AEE, Bilasipara NH-Way Sub-Division, informed that the construction of N.H.Way from Bangalipara to Tillapara has been completed. The DDC, Dhubri requested the AEE, Golokganj NH-Way Sub-Division for taking initiative for repairing of N.H. Way on the stretch from Golokganj to Agomani as the road is badly damaged.

It was resolved that the N.H. Way Authority will make arrangement for fixing of Reflectors on trees ahead of Chapar Town.

6. Sales Tax Deptt :-

The Assistant Commissioner of State Tax, Dhubri informed that the revenue collected in the month of October, '2019 is Rs29210991/- and the cumulative total stands at Rs.230817178/-.

It was further reported by the Assistant Commissioner of State Tax, Dhubri that the Brick Kilns are not paying GST. The Chairperson requested him to make assessment by sending teams and arrange for collection of Taxes as per GST.

7. Irrigation Deptt:-

The EE, Dhubri Division Irrigation, Gauripur informed that renovation work of Asharikandi LIS Ph-I under SOPD-SCSP with an estimated amount of Rs. 52.20 lakh is under progress and so far 70% works have been completed. The Chairperson requested him to complete the work by December'2019.

Further, on query, the EE, Dhubri Division Irrigation, Gauripur informed that the selection of Beneficiaries under the scheme Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sichayee Yojana- Har Khet ko Pani (PMKSY-HKP) have finalised and at present the Tender for Dhubri and Gauripur LAC has been called for.

8. Health Dept :-

The Joint Director Health Services, Dhubri informed that altogether 4695 nos. of Anti-Natal Check Up registered in the District till September 2019. The Chairperson requested him to make suitable strategy for enhancing ANC Registration to meet up the requirement as fixed by NITI Aayog.

It was further informed by the Joint Director, Health Services, Dhubri that the Health Mela organised at Bilasipara has been completed successfully.

Regarding shortage of ANMs in the District as pointed out by the Joint Director, Health Services, Dhubri, the DDC, Dhubri suggested him to take up the matter with the MD, NHM, Assam for posting of ANMs immediately to the District to meet up the shortage.

9. PHE:-

The E.E, PHE, Dhubri informed that the Geo-Tagging of 142295 nos. of IHHL out of 147477 (96.49%) for 2019-20 under Swachh Bharat Mission (G) has been achieved. He informed that the target for completion of Geo-Tagging by the Swaachgrahis has been fixed on 15th of this month.

On query from the Chair, it was informed that the Geo tagging will be completed by the end of this month.

The E.E, (Agri), Gauripur informed that a Soil Testing Centre will start functioning under RIDF in the Office Complex of DAO, Dhubri shortly.

11. DI&CC:

The GM, D.I & C.C, Gauripur informed that Training on Jute Processing at Golokganj has been under progress. He suggested for taking up of training on Food Processing by NRLM in collaboration with DI&CC, Gauripur for the benefits of local people as there is immense scope in this field. The Chairperson requested DPM, ASRLM for chalking out a training programme accordingly in consultation with the PD, DRDA, Dhubri.

The LDM, Dhubri informed that altogether 902nos. of beneficiaries were provided with loans under different sectors in the recently held Loan Mela in Dhubri. The Chairperson, Dhubri requested him to submit a detailed report.

It was further informed by the LDM, Dhubri that due to unavailability of proper address of many applicants applied for benefits under SVAYEM, loan could not be sanctioned. The Chairperson requested him to contact GM, DI&CC, Gauripur in this regard and get the address corrected.

The FLC, RSETI, Dhubri requested for giving priority to the persons for loan who are already trained for encouraging locals to go for training and self employment. The DDC, Dhubri suggested him to share the list of trained person with GM, DI& CC, Gauripur and PD, DRDA, Dhubri.

12. PWD (Building) :-

The Chairperson requested E.E, PWD (Bldg), Dhubri to submit Utilisation Certificate of all the Untied fund schemes sanctioned during 2016-17 latest by 10th of this month for onward submission to the Govt. in Transformation & Development Department.

13. Cooperation :-

The Chairman requested the DRCS, Dhubri to verify the list of 22 nos. of Dairy Societies jointly with the DVO, Dhubri and submit report.

14. Fishery :-

The DFDO, Dhubri informed that on an average 80% civil works completed under RIDF,2018-19 in respect of Farmers Individual Ponds and Village Community Tank. Similarly 90 % civil works completed under Blue Revolution, 2017-18 in respect of Creation of fingerling Rearing Area and Const. of Fish Seed Hatcheries. He assured the House that the scheme will be completed by December'2019.

15. Sericulture :-

The Assistant Director, Sericulture, Dhubri informed that a new scheme viz. Muga Mission will be launched in the District under which Plantation of Som trees will be taken up. Presently selection of beneficiaries is going on.

Regarding proposal for cultivation of Muga through Farmers Society, the DDC, Dhubri requested him to take up the matter with the BDO, Chapar-Salkocha Dev. Block and BDO, Bilasipara Dev. Block. and submit Proposals through Gaon Sabha for consideration for implementation in convergence with MGNREGA.

16. Water Resources :-

The representative of the E.E, Dhubri W.R. Division, Dhubri informed that a new scheme has been sanctioned under NABARD-RIDF for protection of one & halh Km. of reach on the Right bank of downstream of River Gangadhar. The necessary working Order in this regard have been issued.

17. AUWS&SB :-

The E.E, AUWS&SB, Dhubri informed that an electric wire line is running over the Overhead Water Reservoir at Paulpara and requested for immediate removal of the same for safety.

The DDC, Dhubri requested the AGM, APDCL, Dhubri to take steps for shifting of Electric wire line immediately.

The DTO, Dhubri informed that as resolved in the last meeting they have started seizing of Chinese made TOTO and registration of Indian made TOTO.

The DDC, Dhubri requested the DTO, Dhubri to register the TOTOs only on receipt of clearance of APDCL.

19. Social Welfare :-

<u>POSHAN Abhiyan</u>: The DSWO, Dhubri informed that they have received the necessary Weighing Machines and other instruments including mobiles under the scheme POSHAN Abhiyan. However, the required SIM Card is yet to be received.

MAHILA SHAKTI KENDRA: As per direction of Govt. the recruitment of 1 no. Women Welfare Officer and 2 nos. of District Coordinator has already been completed and they have joined the duty.

PRADHAN MANTRI MATRU VANDHANA YOJANA (PMMVY): It was reported that so far they have uploaded 22502 nos. of beneficiaries under the scheme and so far 17895 nos. of beneficiaries have received fund.

20. BADP & Other Schemes:-

The House reviewed the progress of different schemes implemented under BADP, MPLAD, MLAADS and requested implementing agencies especially CEO, ZP, Dhubri & EE.PWD (R/R), Dhubri to expedite the completion of works and submit UCs.

MISCELLANEOUS :-
